PHYSIO WORKSHOPS 2019

ELECTROPHYSICAL THERAPY WORKSHOP

ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSION ACT 2016 (ACT 774)



LAWS OF MALAYSIA

Act 774

ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONS ACT 2016

Falsely personating, using or holding out as a registered practitioner

35. (1) A person who is not registered under this Act shall not—

(a) falsely personate a registered practitioner;

(b) take or use any name, title, addition or description implying that he is a registered practitioner or that he is recognized by law as a registered practitioner;

(c) use any form of diagnostic, investigative or therapeutic equipment or device to induce any person to believe that he is a registered practitioner; or

(d) hold himself out, by advertisement or otherwise, as being qualified or authorized to practise as a registered practitioner.

(2) Any person who contravenes subsection (1) commits an offence and shall, on conviction, be liable to a fine not exceeding fifteen thousand ringgit or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding

The Allied Health Professions Act 2016 or better known as Act 774 was gazetted on 16 February 2016 and came into effect on 1 July 2020. This Act governs 23 allied professions, including physiotherapy, and covers both government and private practice sectors. It details standards of practice, professional protocols, guidelines and code of ethics.

The drafting of this Act first began in 1989. Mrs. Foong Yee Kai was tasked to lead a group of the country's pioneer physiotherapists in drawing up the first drafts of the guidelines. The mantle was then picked up by Ms. Ng Choo Bing in 1993 and then followed by Datin Hjh. Asiah Mohd Hashim in 1995, Pn. Haironi Ismail in 2015, Pn. Halimah Hashim in 2019 and Pn. Nur Hidayah Ong Abdullah currently.

With the commencement of the Act, the country's 40,000 allied health professionals in the public and private sectors will be required to register with the Health Ministry.

Prior to Act 774, all healthcare workers were governed by their profession's regulations, except for allied health practitioners who relied on individual policies and guidelines. Through the implementation of the Act, the professional conduct and ethics of allied health workers, who also include dietitians, clinical psychologists, diagnostic radiographers, and more can be better monitored because they will be governed by the Malaysian Allied Health Profession Council. This law will ensure that the best quality of healthcare is provided to patients and make certain that future scholars who pursue a career as an allied health professional must meet the requirements of registration and adhere to a code of ethics and professional conduct determined by the Council.




GUIDELINE MEETING






