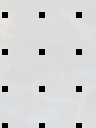
Poster Number

- A Poster number will be printed on the board by the Secretariat.
- Please make sure you mount your poster on the board with the number assigned to you.



Poster Mounting

Please use the pushpins provided by the Congress Secretariat for mounting your poster onto the poster board.



Guidelines for Poster Presentation



Poster Layout

- The contents should be clearly structured under the headings of Introduction, Problem statement, Methods, Results, and Conclusions.
- Heading fonts should be larger in size than body text.
- Make sure the poster is not crowded with text.



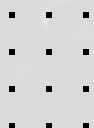
Poster Design

- Posters can be designed using computer programs such as PowerPoint, CorelDRAW or Adobe InDesign.
- White text on a dark background may be used, but only sparingly.
- In general, white, muted, or pastel backgrounds with black text are the best options.
- Use an appropriate balance of text and images to convey your message in an easy-to-read way



Text and Font Size

- The text should be concise in order to ensure good visibility at approximately 3 feet.
- Please include all the most important ideas, but not necessarily all the fine details.
- The font size of the body text must not be smaller than 20 points.
- Text should be single-spaced.
- Do not use ALL UPPER-CASE TEXT because it is difficult to read.



Guidelines for Poster Presentation

Tables and Illustrations

- Tables should be simple and easy to follow.
- The legend of a figure should appear below the figure.
- Illustrations are more appealing if they are in color.

References

Please include eight pertinent references at most.

Permissions for Images

- Please ensure that you have permission to use any images you include in the poster.
- This includes a license for copyrighted materials and consent forms from patients who are recognizable in photographs or images.

Interest

- Financial interest, if any, must be disclosed and included in the poster.
- Presentations made at the Congress must not be used to promote a commercial product.

Poster Set Up and Take Down

- Setup up: 24 May 2024 morning.
- Take down: 25th May 2024 before the event ended

ROUND 01

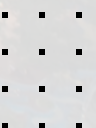
ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

- Individuals or teams will need to prepare abstract of their research according to the abstract template by **31 January 2024**
- **Link for abstract template: tinyurl.com/templatePosterAbstractMPC24**
- The pdf file should be labelled as **Your Name (or Team Name) - Round 1.pdf**
- Then, Individuals or teams will complete the online abstract submission of their research
- **Link for abstract submission: tinyurl.com/AbstractMPC24**
- Assessor will evaluate all submissions and select finalists that qualify for advancement to Round 2

PRESENTATION AT MPC 2024

- The team will make a **5-minute presentation** to a panel of judges. This will be followed by a **3-minute question and answer session**
- The official announcement of the winners will take place at the end of the program.

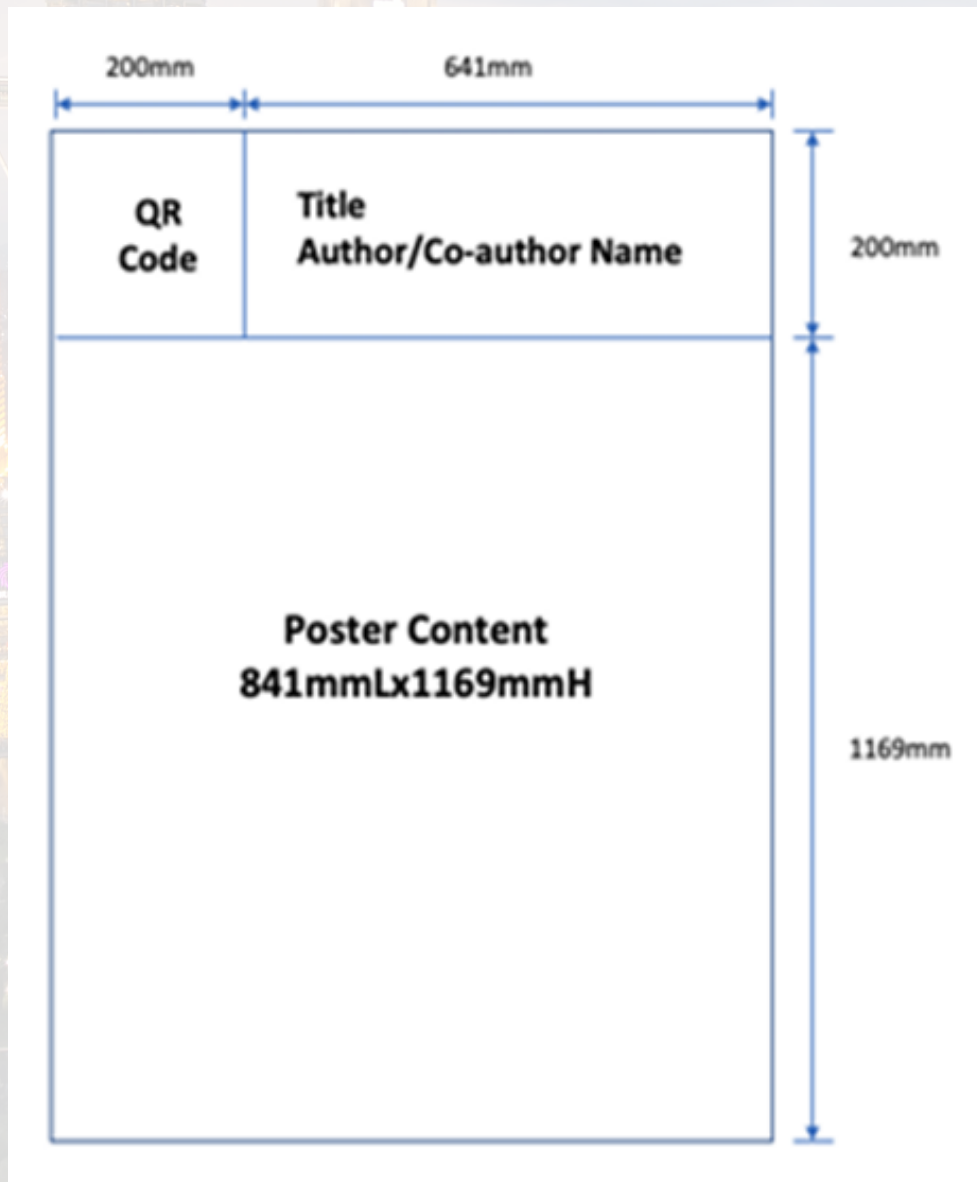


Guidelines for Poster Presentation

- It should be in portrait orientation.
- Poster Size: 1189mm (height) x 841mm (width) AO size
